Having a core and solid foundation is very useful. This may seem rather obvious but it's the obvious elements of our lives that we should spend time reflecting and encouraging. When we have a solid foundation, it helps us through everything in our lives. It helps us to enjoy the times when everything is going right for us. It also helps us to endure when everything is falling apart. Paul, as he is writing to the Philippians, is talking about how he can live with abundance and in want. The way he has learned to do this is because of his relationship with Christ. "I can do all things in him who strengthens me." Now Paul is thanking the community for helping him during his own trials but he wants them to see how much Christ has given him to overcome everything. Remember, Paul had been marooned in a shipwreck, jailed several times, and beaten and left for dead several times. Paul is encouraging the Philippians and us that it is through Christ that we can survive all the negativity that comes our way. This is why it is so important to work on our relationship with Jesus. We are called to do this not just on Sunday but every day. We can do this by praying a daily rosary, reading a few verses of Scripture. Soon we will be able to come and spend time with the Eucharist in our new Adoration Chapel. Whichever way you choose, find the one that helps to strengthen your core. By doing this, you will bring even more peace not just to vour own life but to the entire world.
